

BELKNAP COUNTY  
Public Hearings Notice  
Community Development Block Grant Project

The Belknap County Commissioners will hold four consecutive Public Hearings on Wednesday, June 15, 2016, at 9:00 AM at their offices at 34 County Drive, Laconia, New Hampshire. Community Development Block Grant funds are available to municipalities through the NH Community Development Finance Authority. Up to \$500,000 annually is available for economic development projects, up to \$500,000 for public facility and housing projects, up to \$500,000 for emergency activities, and up to \$12,000 is available per feasibility study grant. All CDBG projects must directly benefit low and moderate income persons. The purpose of the hearings are public comment on the following:

1 A proposed application to the Community Development Finance Authority for up to \$500,000 in Community Development Block Grant funds. The County will retain some of the funds for administration costs and sub-grant the benefits of the remainder to Granite State Children's Alliance for the acquisition and/or rehabilitation of 95 Water Street in Laconia into a Child Advocacy Center, the Greater Lakes Child Advocacy Center. The majority of the GSCA clients are of low or moderate income.

2 The Housing and Community Development Plan.

3 The Residential Antidisplacement and Relocation Assistance Plan.

4 And the progress of LACLT's River's Edge 32 units of new affordable housing at 126 Union Avenue in Laconia.
