2013 BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM AWARD

This agreement is made and entered into this 28th of May, 2014 by and between the COUNTY of Belknap, acting by and through its governing body, the County Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, and the CITY of Laconia, acting through its governing body, the City Council, hereinafter referred to as the CITY, both of Belknap County, State of New Hampshire, witnesseth:

WHEREAS, each governing body, in performing governmental functions or in paying for the performance of governmental functions hereunder, shall make that performance or those payments from current revenues legally available to that party; and

WHEREAS, each governing body finds that the performance of the Agreement is in the best interests of both parties, that the undertaking will benefit the public, and that the divisions of costs fairly compensates the performing party for the services or functions under this agreement; and

WHEREAS, the CITY agrees to provide the COUNTY \$2,000.00 from the JAG award for the Laconia Police/Belknap County Sheriffs Law Enforcement Equipment (General) Project, Hand Held Radars or Cruiser Radars; and

WHEREAS, the CITY and COUNTY believe it to be in their best interests to reallocate the JAG funds

NOW THEREFORE, the COUNTY and CITY agree as follows:

Section 1

CITY agrees to pay COUNTY a total of \$2,000.00 of JAG funds.

Section 2

COUNTY agrees to use \$2,000.00 for the Laconia Police/Belknap County Sheriffs Law Enforcement Equipment (General) Project, Hand Held Radars or Cruiser Radars; until November 30, 2014.

Section 3

Each party agrees that each jurisdiction establish its own fund for received JAG funds.

Section 4

Each party to this Agreement will be responsible for its own actions in providing services under this agreement and shall not be liable for any civil liability that may arise from the furnishing of the services by the other party.

Section 5

The parties to this Agreement do not intend for any third party to obtain a right by virtue of this agreement.

Section 6

Each party to this Agreement will provide data necessary for Quarterly and Annual Reporting as required.

Section 7

By entering into this Agreement, the parties do not intend to create any obligations express or implied other than those set out herein; further, this Agreement shall not create any rights in any party not a signatory hereto.
